COUNTY TO CONSIDER TRIPLING SPENDING ON SUBSTANCE USE DISORDERS

SAN DIEGO, CA – San Diego Councilmember Chris Ward (District Three) issued the following statement on the County's decision to increase funding - from \$54.6 million to \$179.6 million - for Substance Use Disorders (SUDs).

"The County's decision to increase funding for Substance Use Disorders is a step in the right direction to address an illness that impacts individuals experiencing homelessness. Now that additional funding has been allocated the County needs to ensure those resources are efficiently and appropriately delivered."
