COUNCIL APPROVES SIX-MONTH EXTENSION OF THE SELECT COMMITTEE ON HOMELESSNESS AND REAPPOINTMENT OF COUNCILMEMBERS

SAN DIEGO, CA – San Diego Councilmember Chris Ward (District Three) issued the following statement after Council approval of a six-month extension (July, 2018 through December, 2018) of the Select Committee on Homelessness and the reappointment of Councilmembers Ward (Chair), Gomez (Vice Chair), Kersey, and Sherman to the committee.
