# Budget Review Committee Public Comment Hearing Thursday, April 30 at 6 p.m.


The City has a new system in place for live participation during the Budget Review Committee hearings.

In lieu of in-person attendance, the public may participate and provide comment via telephone, using the Budget Review Committee <u>webform</u>, email submission or via U.S. Mail of written materials.

This proposed FY '21 budget has been severely impacted by the pandemic. Proposed cuts will disproportionately impact our community, including library closures on the weekend, cutting the FREE STAR/PAL program (the only one of its kind in the city), and many other impacts to neighborhood services.

We are committed to fighting for the equitable distribution of funding.

We must use a scalpel as opposed to a hatchet for these cuts.



### **CALL TO ACTION**

We encourage all of you to make your demands known during the public hearings. We are not willing to sit idly by as our community needs are ignored and go unmet.


#### TACKLING FOOD INSECURITY
