This month, Campaign Zero released the “Evaluating Policing in San Diego” report.

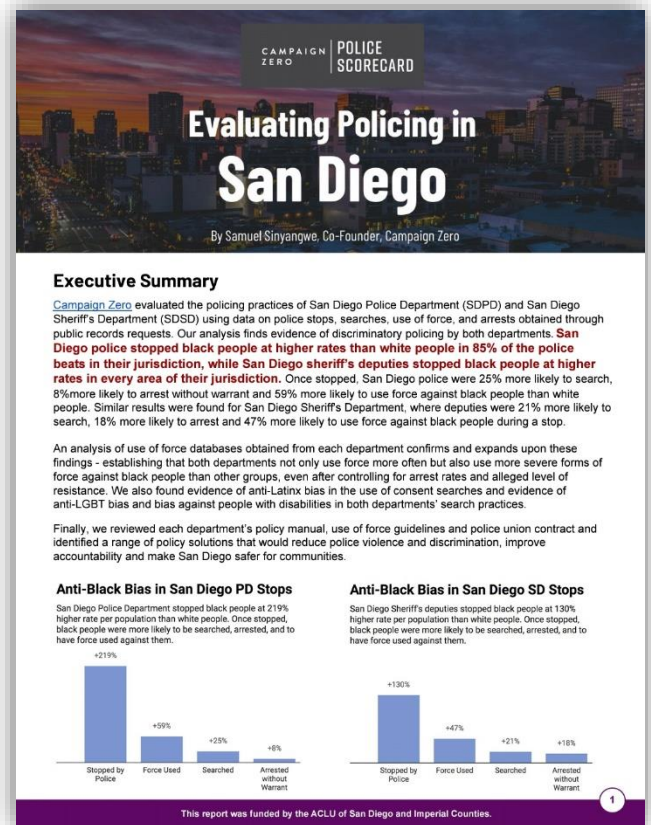

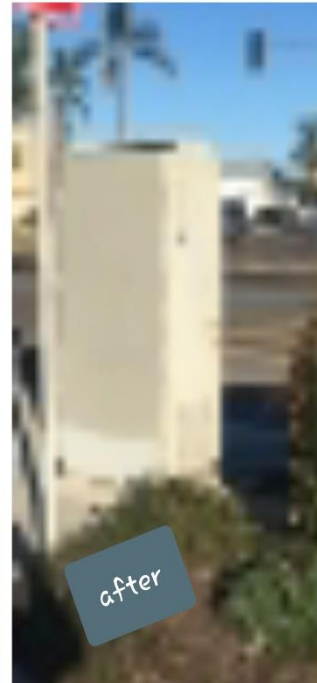

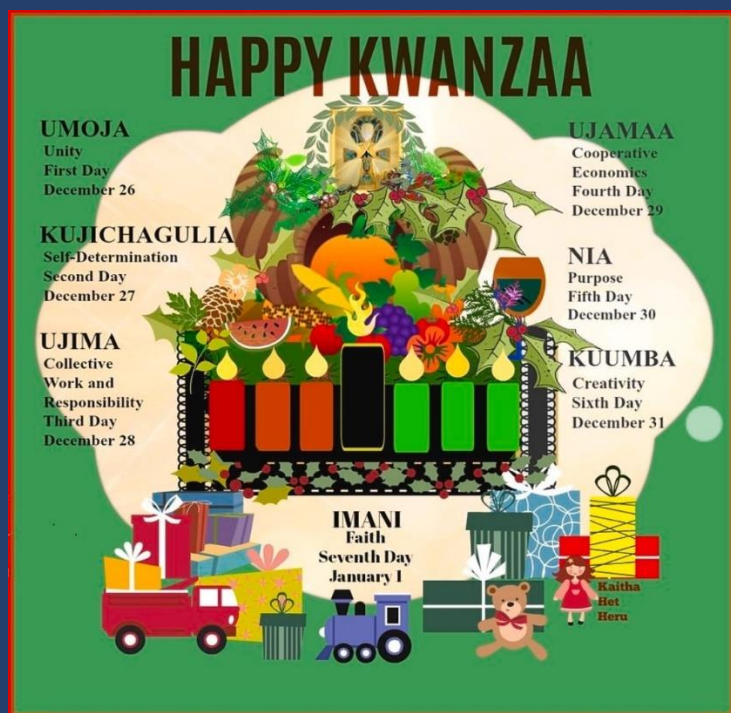
