

## STATEMENT ON THE CALL FOR EQUITY IN ENFORCEMENT

"As restrictions were relaxed over the weekend in order to allow passive use of City beaches, video footage was captured of a young Black woman walking her dog, being detained, and eventually arrested by the San Diego Police Department.

"The footage is particularly concerning and disturbing, as this incident occurred on the heels of protests that clearly violated the public health orders. No arrests were made.

"My office is demanding answers as to why this young woman did not receive equitable enforcement and treatment. We have reached out to the leadership at the San Diego Police Department and the Mayor's Office, and look forward to their swift response," said Councilmember Monica Montgomery, chair of the Committee on Public Safety and Livable Neighborhoods.
