## **Sherman Releases White Paper Comparing Proposed Mission Valley Ballot Measures**

### *Lack of Information in “Friends of SDSU” Measure Troubling*

**San Diego** – As the District 7 Representative on the City Council, which includes Mission Valley, Councilmember Scott Sherman released a white paper comparing the Soccer City ballot measure with the recently released “Friends of SDSU” ballot measure.

The report analyzed the following aspects of the two ballot measures:

- Housing
- Stadium size and cost to taxpayers
- Value of SDCCU Stadium Land and what proponents will pay
- SDSU School expansion
- Traffic mitigation to Mission Valley community

Unfortunately, due to the lack of information in the 13 page “Friends of SDSU” ballot measure, there are many troubling unknowns.

Due to lack of specifics, it is impossible to determine the impacts the “Friends of SDSU” proposal will have on the Mission Valley community and San Diego taxpayers. Councilmember Sherman urges San Diegans to refrain from signing the ballot measure currently being circulated.

“San Diegans deserve to review the details before committing to placing the measure on the ballot. As I have said numerous times in the past, devil is in the details,” said Sherman
