## LAND USE AND HOUSING COMMITTEE TO HEAR PUBLIC INPUT ON HOUSING AFFORDABILITY

SAN DIEGO – The City of San Diego’s Land Use and Housing Committee will have its first meeting of the year tomorrow and will hear public input and ideas on how to reform housing policy and make housing more affordable for San Diegans. Interested members of the public and housing stakeholders have been invited to participate in an open and transparent exchange of ideas in an effort to find solutions that are effective and actionable.

“Many District 8 residents I talk to are concerned about housing affordability and availability,” said Committee Chair Vivian Moreno. “It is our responsibility at the City to ensure we do all we can to allow our residents to have the ability to live where they work and be able to access housing opportunities in all neighborhoods in the City.”

The committee meeting will be held on **Wednesday, January 16 at 2PM at City Hall** on the 12<sup>th</sup> floor. The discussion on housing reform, which is [Item 5 on the agenda](#), will be taken up at the beginning of the meeting.
