If patients need further in-person care, they will be directed to the best way to receive care without compromising their health or the health of others. The SYHealthline is available Monday to Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Saturday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. In addition, San Ysidro Health also has a testing line, 619-205-6365, for individuals that would like to be tested for COVID-19.
