New Audit Committee Member Appointed by the City

SAN DIEGO- Today, the San Diego City Council appointed a new public member to the City of San Diego's Audit Committee, Mr. Andrew Maffia, for a term ending January 5, 2025.

“As Chair of the Audit Committee, I can speak to how important it is to preserve the independence of our Audit Committee and the Office of the City Auditor,” said Audit Committee Chair Moreno. “Mr. Maffia is well qualified and has a long record of leading the government related audits at his firm and I believe that experience would serve the Audit Committee well.”

Candidates were evaluated based on the criteria set forth in City Charter section 39.1 which provides that public members of the Audit Committee must possess the independence, experience, and technical expertise necessary to carry out the duties of the Audit Committee. This expertise includes knowledge of accounting, auditing, and financial reporting. The minimum professional standards for public members must include at least 10 years of experience as a certified public accountant or as a certified internal auditor, or 10 years of other professional financial or legal experience in audit management.
