Community Rally for Beyer Park Monday

SAN DIEGO – On Monday, June 13, the San Diego City Council will convene for a Special Meeting for approval of the City's FY 2023 Budget. Councilmember Moreno is urging her colleagues to support her one-time funding request of \$2.2M to be allocated to the Beyer Park project as part of the adopted FY23 budget.

Councilmember Moreno has been advocating for the development of Beyer Park since she was elected. Beyer Park was promised to the community decades ago and numerous challenges have delayed this project. San Ysidro residents suffer from a lack of open spaces and parks in San Ysidro and there is a dire need for basic amenities other communities have such as trees, athletic and recreation facilities.

The Beyer Park project is located at Beyer Boulevard and Enright Drive in San Ysidro. Final design has been completed and there is a funding gap of \$2.2M for Phase I due to cost increases and changes to the scope of the project. This funding will allow construction to move forward on schedule and to ensure the City does not risk losing state and federal grant funding for this project.
