I, ELIZABETH MALAND, City Clerk of, California, DO HEREBY CERTIFY the results of the canvass of the votes cast in the General Election held on Tuesday, November 6, 2018, to be as follows, to wit:

- (a) The Otay Mesa Enhanced Infrastructure Financing District had 8,930 registered voters eligible to vote in the November 6, 2018 election;
- (b) The number of votes of qualified registered voters in the area encompassing the Otay Mesa Enhanced Infrastructure Financing District is as follows:
- (d) The measure voted upon, and the number of votes given for and against each measure are as follows:

MEASURE O.

APPROVING BOND ISSUANCE FOR PUBLIC FACILITIES IN OTAY MESA. Without increasing the property tax rate, shall the Public Financing Authority for the Otay Mesa Enhanced Infrastructure Financing District (District) authorize the District to issue up to \$230 million in tax increment bonds to finance public facilities, including roads, parks, police and fire stations, libraries, water lines, and sewers, identified in the District's Infrastructure Financing Plan?

This measure requires the affirmative vote of fifty-five percent (55%) of the qualified voters within the District.

For said measure the vote was 3,164 (75.23%).

Against said measure the vote was 1,042 (24.77%).

THE TOTAL VOTE WAS 4,206 (100%).

- (e) The number of votes given in each precinct to each person, and for and against the MEASURE, are recorded in the Elections Return Book, which book is authorized and is considered a part of the record of the City of San Diego.
