GENTLEMEN:

Returned is Document No. 384656, a communication from the Council of Chambers of Commerce and Civic Clubs, urging establishment of a baseball field in Balboa Park.

The Park Commission is of the opinion that the baseball diamond at Morley Field meets the present need. Development of an alternate field would be limited to the area occupied by the riding academy, and nothing can be begun on that site until provision is made for relocating the stables and academy in Morley Field area, as is now contemplated.
