GENTLEMEN:

I am forwarding the application of Albert Bertolino and Una Marie Bertolino for license to conduct public dance on premises where intoxicating liquor is sold. The premises in question are known as 820 Broadway.

Certain remodeling by way of additional exits will be required before this application will be approved by the Building Inspector and the Fire Department. However, it does not appear reasonable to require the applicant to make the changes prior to the time that he is informed of the Council's views with respect to dine and dance establishments on upper Broadway in the downtown area. If the Council determines that dine and dance permits should be granted with respect to this general area on Broadway, then I recommend that permit be granted to Albert Bertolino subject to the installation of the exits and exit lights in a manner to be approved by the Building Inspector.
