PLANNING DEPARTMENT

It has come to the attention of the Planning Commission that the Navy plans construction of a swimming pool on the Navy Field at the foot of Fifth Avenue, which would interfere very seriously with the proposed relocation of Lane Field to that area.

The Planning Department has presented sketches to the Navy showing how the pool may be relocated so that it will not interfere with the future development of Lane Field or interfere with the present developments and usability of the Navy Field.

The Planning Commission, after discussing this matter, passed the following resolution:

"That the Planning Commission recommend to the City Council that they request the Commandant to give consideration to relocating the proposed swimming pool which under the present location would severely interfere with the City's plans for the future of Lane Field."
