City Officials: Boards, Commissions, and Committees

Any member of a "City Board" is defined as a "City Official" for purposes of the Municipal Lobbying Ordinance.

According to the ordinance, the definition of "City Board" includes the boards of directors of all City agencies, and any board, commission, committee, or task force of the City established by action of the City Council under authority of the City Charter, Municipal Code, or Council resolution, whose members are required to file a statement of economic interests (a Form 700) pursuant to the California Political Reform Act of 1974, as amended.
