Solution Staging Areas

- Staging areas are utilized to temporarily store pipe, bedding, backfill material, and construction equipment
 - Located adjacent to construction work area, typically within City right-of-way
 - Contractor is responsible for identifying staging locations
 - Requires approval by the City's construction management staff
 - Must all be located on paved or cleared surfaces

Solution Storage Yards

- Storage yards are locations where a contractor may choose to store surplus materials, larger equipment, office trailers, etc.
 - May be located on private property and require exclusive agreements between the contractor and that private property owner
 - All storage areas must be located on paved or cleared surfaces
