It is my distinct pleasure to nominate Mr. Josh Clark to the Bicycle Advisory Committee.

Mr. Clark is a Senior Planner with Alta Planning and Design and has worked on several major bike projects throughout San Diego. He received his Bachelor's Degree in History from UCLA and his Masters in City Planning from San Diego State University. Working with the San Diego Association of Governments, Mr. Clark developed a dynamic visual guide showcasing the 25-mile long Bayshore Bikeway. He also worked on the Uptown Regional Bike Corridors, establishing a data model and methodology to maximize benefits along the project areas. Because of this important work, Uptown's proposed bike boulevards and cycle tracks have been some of the first Early Action Projects funded. Mr. Clark has also worked on the "Bikes Count!" project for the County of San Diego Health and Human Services Agency.

Mr. Clark has extensive experience with a variety of transportation-related projects, and he is passionate about improving transportation options in San Diego.
