Executive Office of Immigration Review*, United States District Court Case No. 3:21-cv-00463 (Northern District of California), to join in the litigation as an amicus participant in the County of Los Angeles' brief supporting Centro Legal de la Raza's motion for a preliminary injunction which challenges the implementation of an administrative regulation promulgated by the Trump Administration in December 2020. The subject administrative regulation changes an immigration procedure known as "administrative closure" and significantly alters Board of Immigration Appeals' procedures.
