## Key Takeaways – Mobility Existing Conditions

- Add pedestrian emphasis on Montezuma, from College Ave to ECB,
- Address the missing gap on College Ave. Consider a shared ped/bike crossing across SDSU property.
- Add pedestrian emphasis on ECB east of Montezuma to connect to La Mesa. Include street trees pedestrian lighting, and other sidewalk improvements.
- Caution when proposing a cycle track on Montezuma (from College Ave to Fairmount) due to the steep terrain. Cycle tracks present the potential conflicts: 1) non cyclists using the bike lane (e-bikes, scooters, pedestrians), and 2) cyclists will be physically unable to escape the cycle track. Consider other options: buffered bike lanes, green paint for visibility, etc.
- Linear park along Montezuma Road, from College Ave to ECB, to accommodate pedestrians and cyclists.
- Consider continuing the prioritization of transit on ECB, from College Ave to Montezuma to close the gap and connect to La Mesa. Pair this with prioritizing pedestrians to support the transit. This is a key commercial corridor.
- Consider micro transit/trams to connect to SDSU and throughout the community to focus on first mile/last mile.
