Gentlemen:

The City Clerk has transmitted to you by registered mail Resolution No. 91234, adopted by the City Council on June 12, 1945, which suspends your cabaret license for the Pirates Cave Cafe for a period of thirty days or until re-application for a license is made, whichever is longer.

The City Council has directed me to also notify you that if any violations occur in the future at the Pirates Cave or other places of entertainment operated by your organization, both cabaret and dance licenses will be immediately and permanently revoked. I am sure that you fully understand the City's position in this matter, and will give us full cooperation in the future by operating in accordance with City regulations.

You will note under terms of Ordinance No. 507, New Series, that in order to reestablish your license at the end of the period of suspension, it will be necessary for you to file an application in accordance with Section 6 of Ordinance No. 507. A copy of Section 6 is attached for your information, and it is suggested that you contact the License Division of the Treasurer's Office and the Police Department concerning this matter in ample time to secure reinstatement of your license at the end of the thirty day period of suspension, if you wish to resume entertainment at the Pirates Cave Cafe.
