GENTLEMEN:

RE Suspension of cabaret license of Pirate's Cave

Ordinance No. 507 (NS) contains the following provisions:

Section 18

"No entertainment shall be given in any cabaret in the City of San Diego of a lewd, suggestive, vulgar or immoral type. Entertainers shall not use objectionable or obscene language, and shall not sing songs of a lewd, obscene, or a vulgar character."

Section 6

"The City Manager shall also recommend to the City Council for cause at any time the suspension or revocation of any license granted or issued hereunder, and in case of such recommendation for suspension or revocation, the City Manager shall give written notice thereof to the licensee, stating his reasons."

Under date of June 6th, 1945, the City Manager, F. A. Rhodes, gave written legal notice to Walter R. Stutz Enterprises, the owners and operators of the Pirate's Cave, 402 W Broadway, informing them of their violation of Section 18 of Ordinance 507 (NS) and stating that he would recommend appropriate action to the City Council for revocation or suspension of the cabaret license of the Pirate's Cave.

The Director of Social Welfare and the Chief of Police have both reported to the City Manager that the entertainment at the Pirate's Cave has been clearly in violation of Section 18 of Ordinance 507 (NS) and that this violation has continued over a period of time despite frequent warnings to the management both by the Police Department and the Director and Investigators of the Social Welfare Department.

Recommendation:

1. It is recommended that the cabaret license of the Pirate's Cave be immediately suspended for a period of 30 days in accordance with the attached resolution prepared by the City Attorney.

It is recommended that the owners and management of the Pirate's Cave be informed that if any violations occur in the future, both the cabaret and dance licenses of the Pirate's Cave, or any other similar cabarets or dance halls operated by Walter R. Stutz Enterprises, will be immediately and permanently revoked.
