GENTLEMEN:

I am forwarding herewith to your Honorable Body the application for license to conduct a public dance on premises where intoxicating liquor is sold of Robert B. and Jennie Maples. The premises are located at 4693 University Avenue.

As required by Section 9 of Ordinance No. 581 (N.S.) I am transmitting my recommendation with respect to this application, namely, that the license applied for be denied. Approximately two years ago, when a similar application for this location was under consideration, a like recommendation was made. I know of no facts which would justify a change in the previous recommendation. The past conduct of this establishment is not the basis for this recommendation, but in my judgment the location is not a suitable or proper place for the conduct of such business.

I am returning Document No. 340391 previously referred to me, the same being a petition filed with your Honorable Body by residents in the neighborhood of 4693 University Avenue.
