
THE HONORABLE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL

GENTLEMEN:

At a recent meeting you referred to us a petition relative to conditions in the vicinity of the Tavern Hacienda, at 47th and University Avenues.

You will please be advised that we have taken this matter up with the Police Department and, in view of the fact that the new State Law regulating the sale of liquor and places where liquor is sold will go into effect within a short time, and, furthermore, it is the opinion of Chief of Police George M. Sears and myself that until the regulations of the State are made known to us and become effective, the condition complained of can be remedied by prohibiting parking on both sides of 47th Street from University Avenue to Wightman Street from 7:30 P.M. to 2:00 A.M.
