Gentlemen;

On October ninth our dance license was suspended. This action was taken largely upon the testimony of Mr. Wheeler, who said, -"I can heartily endorse the cleaning out of this dirty bunch. We have some apartments near there worth \$33,000.00 and it has gone to the dogs because along side of me this goes on. They closed at 12.45 last night- we got no sleep. My wife got up Sunday morning and said, 'I am going to the mountains'. She has to be driven out of her own home by that dirty rotten bunch of hoodlums. Niggers come along under the windows and call each other all kinds of foul names and curse and swear and carry on. We will just have to do something."

Mr. Wheeler, who is 83 years old, lives at 3004 Imperial Ave, - just one mile from our place, - and he was referring to a place at 3008 Imperial, not ours.

In view of this misunderstanding and also the recent decision of the Council to suspend licences for a thirty day period upon justified complaints, I herewith respectfully petition that my dance license be re-instated.

Attached hereto is a petition signed by over a hundred of our neighbors who wish us to resume dancing.

We would like to take this opportunity to state that we will always be glad to cooperate with the Chief of Police and the State Board in enforcing the ordinances and laws regulating this business.
