## SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT

On June 21, 1938, Josie Sciuto applied for a dine-dance license at this same location. At that time a thorough investigation of community sentiment was made and recommendation for denial was made by both the Chief of Police and Director of Social Welfare. Applicant was at that time represented by counsel who, being convinced that the City Council would deny his client's application, asked for a withdrawal of her application on July 26, 1938. Withdrawal was permitted by the Council on that date.

Investigation proves that previous conditions and community sentiment are unchanged. Accordingly in the interests of public welfare and morals, under Section 8 of Ordinance 581, I again recommend disapproval of this license.
