SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT

While the closing hour is specified in Ordinance 10,243 as 1:00 O'clock A.M., the opening hour is not specified. Consequently, this license may be granted without change of ordinance.

It has been the City's distinct policy to oppose after-midnight dances; and recommendation of denial would be made on this application if the applicant were an individual dance-hall operator or licensee--because to grant it would be precedent-setting in breaking down the City's policy.

The U.S.O., however, is a nationally recognized non-profit organization deeply interested in service man and defense worker alike. This dance is specifically for Aircraft personnel--to meet a definite need and problem.

I accordingly recommend granting this license upon the following conditions:

1. That either one of each couple admitted must be an Aircraft worker.
2. That pass-out checks will not be permitted.
