Dear Sir:

Replying to your communication of June 9th to Mrs. R. R. Lewis, Pres. of the La Jolla P. T. A. regarding the repeal of Ordinance 7056 relative to the wearing of bathing suits on the business streets of La Jolla, I beg to inform you that the question was thoroughly discussed at a recent meeting of the Executive Board of the La Jolla P. T. A. with the following decision.

The Executive Board recommends that the Ordinance 7056 be not repealed, but modified, to require some sort of covering for those wearing bathing suits, said covering to reach approximately within six inches of the knees; and that this law be made to apply to the whole business section of La Jolla, and not one portion only, as heretofore.
