Several months ago the Encanto Civic Club presented to our group a project calling for the development of a city baseball field in Balboa Park. We set aside an entire meeting for the discussion of this project and had several speakers, including among them Mr. Leo Galland, Mr. Mike Morrow and a representative of the American Legion, so that various points of view could be presented. It was brought to our attention that the Nolan Plan included such a recreation area in Balboa Park, and that City Manager Rhodes had been considering a site for this purpose.
