Re: Relief for California renters and homeowners

Dear Senate President pro Tempore Atkins and Assembly Speaker Rendon,

I am writing to respectfully urge you to enact legislative measures to address the looming evictions crisis in California due to the spread of the COVID-19 pandemic.

On March 25, 2020, the City of San Diego adopted a temporary eviction moratorium to provide relief for tenants in San Diego experiencing economic hardship due to COVID-19. This moratorium expires on September 30, 2020, and allows residents to repay their accumulated rent on September 25, 2020. This September, the Council of the City of San Diego will consider an extension of the repayment period to remain in effect through December 30, 2020.

On August 19, 2020, the San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) released a report indicating that unemployment in our region is reported to be at 14%.¹ This can be compared to the region's unemployment during the Great Recession, which reached its peak at 10.8% in 2010. Many of the hardest hit zip codes continue to be in the central and southern parts of the County, housing traditionally underserved communities that have been disproportionately impacted by the COVID-19 crisis.

Millions of Californians rely on leadership from all levels of government to prevent unnecessary evictions, ensure people are housed during a pandemic, and provide adequate relief to address economic hardship. Specifically, communities are in dire need of protections for tenants and homeowners alike, in the form of emergency rental assistance; an extension of a statewide moratorium with an associated extension of the

period to pay back any unpaid rent; and an extension of mortgage payments. These actions are necessary in order to avoid an exacerbation of our existing housing and homelessness crises.

I applaud your efforts in continuing to ensure the safety of our most vulnerable populations during this pandemic. I urge you to strongly consider legislation that would provide relief for millions of struggling renters and homeowners in California.
