Park and Recreation Coalition Asks San Diego City Council to Delay Action

San Diego, CA: On Tuesday, October 31, 2017 at 2:00 p.m., the San Diego City Council will hear Item 331 "[Amend the Park and Recreation Department Fee Schedule and Appropriate Recreation Council Revenues and Fees.](#)"

If Item 331 is approved, District 6 Recreation Councils could:

- Lose monetary spending authority for their respective neighborhoods
- Have added layers of government bureaucracy
- Diminish their roles in their respective communities

"The City of San Diego works effectively, efficiently, and collaboratively when residents are connected, involved, and engaged. I believe that a change of this magnitude should be vetted and properly planned," stated Councilmember Chris Cate.
