SUBJECT:

Request for Funding: Street Reconstruction Group of Gold Coast Drive, Parkdale Avenue, Gold Coast Way, Gold Coast Court, and Lipscomb Drive

Since first taking office in 2014, it has been a top priority of mine to have the streets Gold Coast Drive, Parkdale Avenue, Gold Coast Way, Gold Coast Court, and Lipscomb Drive, repaved. Each of these streets have consistently been identified by residents, the Mira Mesa Town Council, and the Mira Mesa Community Planning Group as those in most need of repair. Per the last Pavement Condition Assessment, Gold Coast Drive has an OCI of 26.44, Parkdale Avenue OCI 19.23, Gold Coast Way OCI 34.52, Gold Coast Court OCI 11.98, and Lipscomb Drive OCI 23.59

Due to the extreme deterioration of these streets, a full street reconstruction will be required at an estimated cost of \$11.1 million.

To date, \$1.6 million has been allocated toward the design of the street reconstruction project. In addition, Council has been advised that City staff is in the process of determining the project lists for funding from both the upcoming Commercial Paper issuance and Gas Tax funding for Fiscal Year 2021. As the design phase is expected to be completed by the end of the current fiscal year, I respectfully request \$11.1 million be allocated from Gas Tax revenues and/or the next Commercial Paper allocation to fund the reconstruction of Gold Coast Drive, Parkdale Avenue, Gold Coast Way, Gold Coast Court, and Lipscomb Drive.
