Council Extends Interim Urgency Ordinances for Outdoor Business Operations

SAN DIEGO, CA – The San Diego City Council has voted unanimously to extend the interim urgency ordinances to allow for temporary outdoor businesses operations.

The ordinances allow for Temporary Outdoor Business Operations Permits to support the recovery of businesses adversely affected by the COVID-19 pandemic. The extension will last one year even if emergency health orders expire to allow businesses to recover from challenges experienced in the pandemic.

“This extension is important to San Diego businesses to help them survive and recover,” said Council President Jennifer Campbell. “San Diego’s climate is ideal for operating outdoors and I look forward to proposals in the coming months that would make some of these outdoor provisions permanent.”
