- 1. BWC Usage in Secure Facilities
 Proposal to change 1.49 to eliminate the exception of using BWCs in secure facilities such as Sally Port, Detention Rooms etc.
- 2. Warnings Prior to OC Usage Proposal to modify 1.06 to require officers to give a verbal warning prior to using chemical OC spray where possible.
- 3. Time Limits for Maximum Restraint Usage Proposal to modify 6.01 (XIV.) to include a maximum time limit for an individual to be restrained in WRAP devices.
- 4. Seatbelt Utilization
 Proposal to modify 6.01 (XI. H.) increase the requirements necessary
 prior to seatbelts not being used under the officer safety exemption.
- 5. Observation of Detainees in Sally Port
 Proposal to require that officers check on the status/welfare of
 detainees while in Sally Port at a set time interval.
