The City of San Diego set aside \$40 million for road repaving efforts throughout the city and finalized its list of streets in December 2021. More than 50 miles of roads in San Diego's historically neglected communities are slated for repairs through this "Sexy Streets" Initiative.

HOW WERE STREETS SELECTED?

The City of San Diego determined the communities with the most need from a **2019 Climate Equity Index Report** that ranked the city's 297 census tracts on various health, environmental, housing, mobility and socioeconomic indicators.

WHICH STREETS WERE SELECTED IN DISTRICT 9?

There were a total of **33** street segments selected in District 9 which represent **7.8 miles**. Check to see if a street near you was selected:
