<u>Project Scope</u>: The project proposes to create and install new gateways to mark entry into Balboa Park along major vehicular access routes, including Park Boulevard at the north and south ends of the park; Pershing Drive at the north and south ends of the park; and at the southeast corner of the park near Golden Hill. The only gateways within the boundary of the Balboa Park NHL would be at the south end of Park Boulevard. The gateways are generally square with arched passageways and a blue domed roof.

<u>Staff Presentation</u>: The project proposes to create and install new gateways to mark the entry to the park along Park Boulevard. The design of the entry ways are based on the Precis Plan. Staff has previously reviewed the proposed plans and had some concern with the dome and matching the existing architecture of the park.

Applicant Presentation: Currently there is no sense of entry into Balboa Park. It is critical to introduce an entrance along Park Boulevard. When you get off the 163 and turn left, the only way you know you are at the park is the presence of grass. The Precis Plan shows the domes, but only on the south side. When you think of Balboa Park, you think of the Museum of Man which also has a dome. One of the gateway entrances that we are proposing is located within the district the other is located directly across the street outside of the district. We expect that the entrances will be domed with solid precast or poured in place concrete. We are replicating the dome and arches from the existing buildings. We will also have up lights and subtle LED lights on the gateway. At the bottom we will provide acknowledgement of the donors with bronze plaques on the interior. The name "Balboa Park" will not be painted on. It will be incised or protruding out and both sides would match.
