NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to Section 5(c) of that certain Continuing Disclosure Certificate, dated as of April 1, 2015, executed in connection with the above referenced Bonds, that on March 9, 2016, the California Supreme Court (the "Court") declined to hear a petition for review filed by San Diegans for Open Government (the "Appellant") in the Series 2015A Bonds Litigation.

As described in the Official Statement under the caption "PENDING LITIGATION CHALLENGING THE BONDS—Series 2015A Bonds Litigation, Appellant filed a reverse validation lawsuit against the Public Facilities Financing Authority of the City of San Diego (the "Authority"), the City of San Diego (the "City"), the City solely in its capacity as the designated successor agency to the former Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego, and the Housing Authority of the City of San Diego (the "San Diego Entities"), challenging the ordinance of the City and the resolutions of the Authority which approved, among other things, the Authority's Lease Revenue Bonds 2015 Series A (Capital Improvement Projects) (the "2015A CIP Bonds"). The trial court entered judgment in favor of the San Diego Entities with respect to 2015A CIP Bonds, and the California Court of Appeal subsequently affirmed the trial court's judgment.

On December 29, 2015, Appellant filed a petition with the California Supreme Court requesting that the court review the opinion of the Court of Appeal. On March 9, 2015, the California Supreme Court denied Appellant's petition for review of the Court of Appeal's affirmation of the trial court judgment. As Appellant has now exhausted all rights of appeal, the trial court judgment in favor of the City with respect to the 2015A CIP Bonds is final.

The Series 2015B Bonds Litigation remains outstanding as indicated in the Notice of Event filed on January 29, 2016. <u>http://emma.msrb.org/ER938520-ER733517-ER1135055.pdf</u> The San Diego Entities motion for summary judgment is pending at the trial court level in that litigation.
