

How-To Do Easy Folded Book Art in a Daisy Shape

Today I'm going to show you how to make a very easy and fast folded book art piece. All you need is an ordinary paperback book, maybe a couple of paperclips, and about ten minutes! That's it!

The book should be of at least 300 pages.

1. Now, rip off the cover.
2. Open the book to the middle and count out ten pages. Fold the pages into the spine. The fold should be rounded, not creased. It will be a loop shape. This first bit might be easier to paperclip together, until we can get enough loops to be able to wedge it into place.
3. Continue in this way and you'll see that very soon, they will remain wedged in place on their own. It doesn't matter if you loop to the right or left.
4. When you get to the end of one half, you might find you'll need to paperclip. Now continue with the other half!
5. Voila! Your first folded book art piece! Wasn't that fun and easy and fast!? Why not make a bunch!
