The purpose of this affidavit is for the property owner to affirm compliance with the regulations that pertain to owneroccupancy of a property subdivided pursuant to <u>Senate Bill 9 (SB 9</u>) and the <u>San Diego Municipal Code (SDMC)</u> <u>§143.1315</u>.

I propose a lot split (subdivision) of the Premises (Project) in accordance with the provisions of <u>SB 9</u>, codified in the <u>California Government Code</u> (Cal. Govt Code) and incorporated into local regulations in the City of <u>SDMC §143.1303</u> of the Land Development Code as the Multi-Dwelling Unit and Urban Lot Split Regulations for Single Family Zones. I have performed due diligence, including but not limited to a title search and attest to the following:

- The Owner is a trust or LLC and designates an Owner-Affiliated Individual (either a trustee, trust beneficiary, or member), ________, to satisfy this requirement. An Individual or Owner-Affiliated Individual satisfying this requirement shall use the Premises as a primary residence and shall not have more than one primary residence. This requirement shall not be transferred to any successors in ownership except upon the individual's death or medical incapacity to satisfy the residency requirement, in which case the Owner shall supply a qualifying alternate individual to complete the remaining term of the residency.

Acknowledgments:

Owner is electing to develop these Premises pursuant to <u>SB 9</u> and acknowledges that other restrictions, which include both personal obligations as well as obligations that run with the land, may also apply to the Premises and that they may bind me and any successor(s) in ownership, in perpetuity, and I acknowledge that I have a responsibility to comply with all applicable regulations. The Owner has an obligation to comply and maintain compliance with the restrictions and shall, upon request by City, furnish evidence of compliance, the sufficiency of which shall be determined by the City. Compliance with the restrictions is a condition of approval for the Project and failure to comply with one or more restrictions may result in penalties including, but not limited to, revocation of the approval(s) for the Project.
