The information provided by the City's RE for the project will be used by DSD to determine appropriate actions. The top portion of this completed form must be submitted to the RE by the Applicant. The RE will confirm the inspection status and email the fully completed form to the Applicant and to DSD via DSDBondRelease@sandiego.gov for review. DSD will determine appropriate actions and/or eligibility after review of the completed form and notify the Applicant's designated Point of Contact.

NOTE: Insufficient or incomplete inspections will result in the requirement of a new permit or a Completion of Work permit.
