Subject: Week of July 17, Summary of Department Operational Changes in Response to

COVID-19

As the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic is continuously evolving, the Development Services Department (DSD) is adjusting how it provides essential City services to customers. DSD

operational changes are fluid and updated as needed to help ensure the health, safety and well-

being of customers and employees of essential businesses.

\*Note: Due to COVID-19 impacts to customers, employees and DSD operations, the turnaround times for set up, stamp transfer and permit issuance are elongated, and many customers have experienced delays. DSD Management has undertaken strategic personnel reassignments to mitigate the backlog in order to better serve our customers. Additionally, new Open DSD enhancements are being evaluated for the hybrid process. We acknowledge the inconvenience and ask for your continued patience during this transition.

DSD sends process update <u>emails to subscribed customers</u> to keep stakeholders informed of the latest news, as significant operational changes are incorporated. An email recap will be sent at the end of the week if significant changes occur.

Customers are encouraged to visit <u>sandiego.gov/dsd-covid19</u> to keep updated on all of the latest changes. Here is a summary of this week's service changes:

Temporary Outdoor Business Operations: On June 14, the City Council approved an
urgency ordinance that will allow for the Temporary Outdoor Business Operations Permit
to support local retail outlets and restaurants devastated by economic impacts
from COVID-19. The online permit temporarily allows for the expansion of outdoor dining
and retail on to the public right-of-way, private parking lots or public spaces.

Issuance of the temporary permit is subject to new guidelines or mandates for public gatherings and social distancing in accordance with the County of San Diego public health

orders and guidelines from the California Department of Public Health and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. Learn more.

New applications, submittals and construction changes processed entirely online. As of July
1, all new applications for permits and approvals, as well as construction changes for
previously issued permits and deferred submittals, must be processed online by visiting
the DSD home page: <a href="mailto:sandlego.gov/dsd">sandlego.gov/dsd</a>. DSD Information Bulletins and Forms are in the
process of being updated to reflect updated instructions for these digital processes.

Paper applications received before July 1 may continue to be processed in paper format. Still, applicants are encouraged to digitize all project-related files to expedite processing and avoid delays with <u>mandatory quarantine periods in place</u> to review hardcopy files. <u>Learn more</u>. #DigitalDSD
