Conditional Use Permit to modify an existing Wireless Telecommunication Facility (WCF) by reorientating/relocating/reconfiguring six (6) panel antennas mounted inside a radio-frequency transparent cupula textured and colored to match the existing building along with the continued operation of an associated 112 square-foot equipment enclosure housing a GPS, distribution Power cabinets and a switch gear cabinet. The project is located at 1475 Catalina Boulevard in the RS-1-7 zone within the Peninsula Community Plan, Council District 2. Exempt from Environmental. Report No. <u>HO-21-037</u>.

#### ITEM - 2: **\*7248 ENCELIA/7231 ROMERO - PROJECT NO. 624464**

City Council District: 1

Plan Area: La Jolla

A Coastal Development Permit and Site Development Permit to amend Coastal Development Permit No. 11042 and Neighborhood Development Permit No. 11403 to demolish an existing two-story, 5,022 square-foot single family residence at 7248 Encelia Drive (Encelia Property) that was damaged due to a landslide that took place at 7231 Romero Drive (Romero Property) and construct a new single-family residence on each property. The Encelia property proposes a three-story, 8,641 square-foot single family residence with open carport and site improvements, and the Romero property a three-story, 4,945 square-foot single family residence with 3,267 square-foot basement/garage and site improvements. A lot line adjustment will be implemented to create a 0.44-acre lot on the Encelia property and a 0.23-acre lot on the Romero property to construct the residences. The 0.67-acre site is in the RS-1-4 Zone, Coastal (Non-Appealable Area) Overlay Zone, Coastal Height Limitation Overlay Zone, Fire Brush Zone 300-foot Buffer Area, Fire Hazard Severity Zone, Parking Impact Area, and contains Environmentally Sensitive Lands (Steep Hillsides) within the La Jolla Community Plan Area. A Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program (MMRP) will be implemented for Cultural Resources (Archaeology) and Tribal Cultural Resources that will reduce any potential impacts to less than significant. Mitigated Negative Declaration No. <u>624464</u>. Report No. <u>HO-21-040</u>.
