To Whom it May Concern:

On behalf of Ocean Beach Historical Society I would like to recommend that the residence at 3714 Nimitz Blvd be approved for historic designation. The home is a lovely example of the Spanish Eclectic style which typified the best homes built in Ocean Beach in the late '20s and early 1930s. The design is unique, the location is significant and the home appears to be in very original condition.

The original address was 3714 Wabaska Drive which was on the line of D.C. Collier's Point Loma Railroad, the first streetcar to Ocean Beach. Interestingly, due to the way that Nimitz Blvd. was installed as a major artery through the middle of the neighborhood, the home is not simply on a street that changed names, but is actually on a different street completely, yet the structure was never moved.

As a historical society, OBHS supports the preservation of our community's older homes. As a beautiful and unique older home in original condition, we fully support historic designation for 3714 Nimitz Blvd.
