Project Description: The project proposes a Coastal Development Permit to construct a new 2-story single family residence with; 422 square-foot garage. 1,055 square-foot first floor, 1,570 square-foot second floor and roof deck of 362 square feet, totaling 3,409 square-feet and associated site improvements (hardscape and landscaping), on a vacant parcel located at the intersection of El Amigo Road and Crest Way. The 0.12-acre site is zoned RS-1-6 and is designated as Low-Density Residential (5-9 DU/AC) within the Torrey Pines Community Plan area. The project site is also within the Coastal Height Limitation, Coastal Overlay Zone (Non-Appealable -2), Parking Impact Overlay Zone- Coastal, Parking Standards Transit Priority Area, and Transit Priority Area. (LEGAL DESCRIPTION: Lot 40, Block 12 of Del Mar Hills).

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The City of San Diego conducted an Initial Study, which determined that the project could have a significant environmental effect in the following areas: **Cultural Resources** (**Archaeology**), **Tribal Cultural Resources**. The project proposal requires the implementation of specific mitigation identified in Section V of the Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND). The project as presented avoids or mitigates the potentially significant environmental effects identified, and the preparation of an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) would not be required.

On September 8, 2023, the City of San Diego made the above-referenced environmental determination pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
