NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION ENGINEERING & CAPITAL PROJECTS

PROJECT NAME: As-Needed Design Engineering Services for Hospitality Point Comfort Station and Parking Lot Improvements

COMMUNITY PLAN AREAS: Mission Bay Park

COUNCIL DISTRICTS: 2

LOCATION: The project is sited within Hospitality Point and adjacent parking areas located along the 2500 block of Quivira Court, San Diego, CA 92109.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Award an as-needed design engineering services agreement for the Hospitality Point Comfort Station and Parking Lot Improvements project, including geotechnical investigation and related technical studies. The geotechnical investigation would include research, borings and subsurface exploration, mapping, testing, and reporting to provide recommendations for project design.

ENTITY CONSIDERING PROJECT APPROVAL: City of San Diego

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: Statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA State Guidelines Sections 15262 (Feasibility and Planning Studies).

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review which determined that the project meets the statutory exemption criteria set forth in CEQA State Guidelines Sections 15262 (Feasibility and Planning Studies) for approval of the design services agreement only, which includes soils testing activities for geotechnical investigation/evaluation.

Appeals filed by US Mail must have a United States Postal Service (USPS) postmark by the appeal deadline to be considered valid. The appeal application can be obtained [here](#).
