Dear Ms. Herrmann:

The County of San Diego Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) appreciates the opportunity to review and comment on the Final PEIR for the Mission Trails Regional Park Master Plan Update dated February 11, 2019 and has the following comments:

1. DPR requests coordination during all project phases of the planned new trails, facilities or amenities that are proposed on or adjacent to County of San Diego (County) owned land, including land jointly owned with the City of San Diego.
2. DPR requests implementation of design features and operational controls, including fencing around the proposed improved parking area and bike skills course (CM-F3 of the Master Plan), to prevent illegal trespassing and un-authorized trails or other impacts to adjacent County property. DPR is not supportive of a bike skills course or parking lot on the County owned property at this time.
3. DPR requests prior notification and consultation when antenna funds are proposed for use for any maintenance or improvements projects, including construction of new facilities, within Mission Trails Regional Park.

DPR and the City of San Diego have been coordinating on consolidating and updating the Joint Exercise of Power Agreement (JEPA) between our agencies regarding the Tijuana River Valley Regional Park and Mission Trails Regional Park. DPR looks forward to continuing this

coordination and finalizing the JEPA prior to the County Board of Supervisors adopting the Mission Trails Regional Park Master Plan Update.
