As part of my commitment to a strong dialogue with the community, I am writing today about public safety and upcoming events. I am a better Councilmember because of your suggestions and questions, and welcome your input on these and any other City-related matters.

Operation Street Sweep

Responding to your concerns about increased prostitution activity in District Three, I am pleased to report that the San Diego Police Vice Unit conducted a two-day operation called "Street Sweep" this week targeting those individuals who engage in selling women for purposes of prostitution and those individuals who are customers of prostitutes within San Diego.

The operation resulted in the arrests of thirty-four suspects whose charges range from recruiting females for the purpose of prostitution to agreeing to engage in prostitution. Thirty-three males and one female were booked into San Diego Central Jail.

The San Diego Police Department is aggressively addressing street prostitution, human trafficking for the purpose of prostitution, and reducing the demand for prostitution.
