# **Compost Bin Discount Vouchers Now Available**

The City of San Diego's Environmental Services Department (ESD) is excited to announce a new program that is providing City of San Diego residents with discount vouchers for backyard composting bins.

The Compost Bin Voucher Program is year-round and provides City of San Diego residents with a discount on one of three styles of compost bins. Residents can save \$30, \$40, or \$50, depending on the bin they select. One voucher per household, proof of residency required, while supplies last. Applications can be picked up at a Dixieline ProBuild location within City limits or downloadable at <a href="http://www.RecyclingWorks.com">www.RecyclingWorks.com</a>.
