2024 Nomination Period

When are nomination papers due?

Nomination papers and petitions can be submitted no sooner than

> November 16, 2023 and no later than

December 7, 2023

at 5pm at the City Clerk's Office.

What documents are required?

- Statement & Affidavit of Nominee (submitted when pulling papers)
- Petitions with correct number of valid signatures
- Statement of Economic Interest (Form 700)
- Filing Fee of \$574

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- To run for office, you must be a U.S. citizen and at least 18 years old.
- To run for citywide office, you must be a registered voter of the City of San Diego at least 30 days prior to the date you file your nomination papers.
- To run for a district office, you must be a registered voter of the district you want to serve for at least 30 days prior to the date you file your nomination papers.
- Upon taking on any office, you must be a resident of the appropriate jurisdiction.

HOW MANY SIGNATURES ARE NEEDED?

For Mayor or City Attorney: **240 Signatures** from voters registered in the City of San Diego.

For Councilmember: **120 signatures** from voters registered in the district sought.

HOW MUCH IS THE FILING FEE?

The filing fee is **\$574**. For every 3 signatures gathered in excess of the required signatures, \$1 will be refunded to the candidate upon request
