

PUBLIC WORKSHOP

An ad hoc subcommittee of the Ethics Commission will be hosting a public workshop on April 12 at 3:30 p.m. to solicit input and feedback concerning the following proposed changes to the City's campaign laws:

- Extending the one-year pre-election fundraising time period to January 1 of odd-numbered years;
- Modifying the vendor debt time period from 180 days after a debt is incurred to 180 days after an election;
- Permitting the deposit of contributions pending the receipt of contributor information, but requiring the return of contributions if the information is not obtained within 60 calendar days or the last day of the reporting period in which the contribution was received, whichever is earlier;
- Eliminating the requirement that contributors be listed in alphabetical order on campaign statements (since electronically-filed statements can now be searched and sorted by preference);
- Eliminating the requirement that printed and web-based solicitations for contributions include a warning notice regarding reimbursement.
