WHO: All members of the community age 4 to 104 are invited to learn life-saving CPR skills.

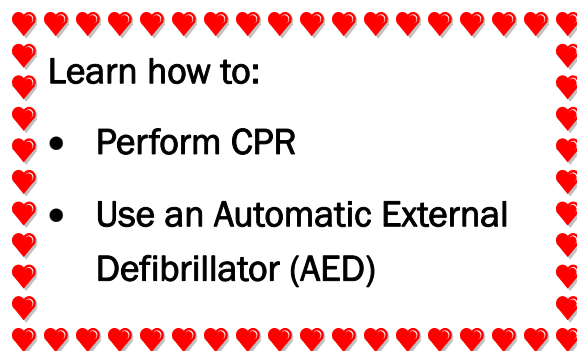
WHAT: Training will last 1 hour.
